To Whom it May Concern:

Thank you for reaching out and sharing your questions regarding the IEEPA tariff charges. We want you to know we appreciate your request and fully understand the importance of clarity around this issue.

At present, the lower court is still evaluating the next steps, which means that neither the government nor the court has established a refund process yet. If the court and government do decide to issue refunds to RFMW we will promptly ensure that any customers who incurred any related charges receive the appropriate reimbursement. The timeline for when this might happen, along with the specific process for requesting and distributing refunds, will depend largely on future guidance and decisions from both the court and the U.S. government.

We are committed to keeping you informed and will provide updates as soon as additional direction becomes available. Please rest assured that transparency is a priority for us, and we will communicate any developments regarding the IEEPA tariff charges as soon as we know more.
